

HEDIS^{®1}: Adults' Access to Preventive or Ambulatory Health Services (AAP)

Description of the measure

Patients 20 years and older who had an ambulatory or preventive care visit during the measurement year. The following screenings can also be rendered during the visit for a more comprehensive examination.

Adults' access (AAP)	An ambulatory or preventive care visit during the measurement year	Office visit codes such as: 99201-99205, 99211-99215, 99241-99245, 99341-99350, 99381-99387, 99391-99397, 99401-99404, 99411-99412, 99429, 99483
Adult body mass index (BMI) assessment	BMI recorded and documented during the measurement year or the year prior	---
Blood pressure screening	Most recent blood pressure reading is <140/90 mm Hg during the measurement year	Systolic and diastolic codes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3074F (systolic <130) • 3075F (systolic 130-139) • 3078F (diastolic <80) • 3079F (diastolic 80-89)
Tobacco screening	Screening for tobacco use at least once within 24 months; cessation counseling if the patient is identified as a tobacco user	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Non-user: 1036F, G9275 • User with cessation counseling: G0436
Depression screening	Screening for depression using a standardized depression screening tool. If positive, a follow-up plan should be documented on the date of the positive screening	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Negative screening: G8510 • Positive screening with care plan documented: G8431

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
